Electronic renewals The NZIS has a special arrangement with specific education providers to make renewals of visas and permits easy for international students. If you are studying through one of these providers, an application can be completed on campus. To enable your application for a Student Visa/Permit or a Limited Purpose Visa/Permit to study to be accepted you **MUST** submit **ALL** of the documents that apply to you that are outlined below. **If you do not do so your application will be returned to you.**

Your partner or accompanying family members cannot be included in this application form. They must submit **SEPARATE** applications for the type of permit they require.

All documents must be in English or translated into English.

1. General Requirements

You must include the following **ORIGINAL** documents:

- a. A completed, signed application form.
- b. The application fee (see our leaflet *New Zealand Immigration's Guide to Fees (NZIS 1028)*, or refer to our website www.immigration.govt.nz).
- c. Your passport or travel document (which must be valid to at least 3 months past the date you plan to leave New Zealand).
- d. A recent passport size photograph attached to the form at the section indicated.
- e. If you are the partner or dependent child of either:
 - a New Zealand resident or citizen, or
 - Diplomatic or Armed Forces Personnel, or
 - a holder of a New Zealand work permit,please proceed to Section 3 and provide any documents as required. The NZIS will request any other documents that are needed to decide your application at a later date.
- f. If you already hold a student visa or permit and you are applying for a further student visa or permit you must provide COPIES of the following:
 - evidence of previous student performance; AND
 - evidence of attendance (excluding tertiary) showing satisfactory progress.

2. Financial Support and Enrolment Details

Please **DO NOT** send cash or other original evidence of funds or travel tickets with this application. Send **COPIES ONLY** of these items in the form of photocopies of travellers' cheques/bank draft/letters of credit or a bank statement in your name.

- a. Please provide **one** of the following as evidence of your ability to support yourself in New Zealand:
 - A completed *Financial Undertaking for a Student (NZIS 1014)* form; OR
 - Evidence of sufficient funds to support yourself for the period you will be studying (If you are studying in New Zealand for less than 36 weeks please provide evidence of NZ\$1000 per month. If you are intending to study in New Zealand for more than 36 weeks please provide evidence of NZ\$10,000 per year as well as sufficient funds to purchase an outward ticket); OR

- If you are a student from Tonga or Samoa intending to study for any length of time you may supply a **Sponsorship Form for Visiting New Zealand** (NZIS 1025).
- b. A guarantee of accommodation.
- c. An offer of a place at a New Zealand education or training institute; OR
For scholarship or exchange or vocational trainee students only – A letter from the provider of the programme outlining the details of the programme you are undertaking.
- d. Evidence that you have paid or are exempt from paying the course fees.

3. Health and Character Requirements

Please refer to the **Guide for Studying in New Zealand** (NZIS 1013) for details of NZIS health and character requirements and provide the required information if relevant to your application. Please provide **ORIGINALS**.

- a. For people aged 12 years and over who will be in New Zealand for more than six months but less than 2 years please provide:
 - A completed **Temporary Entry X-ray Certificate** (NZIS 1096) OR a completed **Medical and X-ray Certificate** (NZIS 1007) **if required** (refer to the **Guide for Studying in New Zealand** (NZIS 1013)).
- b. For people aged 12 years and over who will be in New Zealand for more than 2 years please provide:
 - A completed **Medical and X-ray Certificate** (NZIS 1007); AND
 - If you are aged 17 or over, a **police certificate** from your country of citizenship (or satisfactory evidence that you have never lived in that country), and any country in which you have lived for 5 years or more since attaining the age of 17 years.

Please note: If you decide to apply directly for a Limited Purpose Visa and you are subsequently granted a Limited Purpose Permit, your immigration rights in New Zealand are restricted to fulfilling the “express purpose” to study for which you came.

I understand I am responsible for making sure I leave New Zealand before my permit expires and that if I do not I may face removal action.

Residents and people holding work permits for a stay of two years or more (and their dependent children) are eligible for publicly funded health and disability services. Other work permit holders, students, and visitor permit holders generally are not eligible. People covered by New Zealand’s Reciprocal Health Agreements with Australia and the United Kingdom are entitled to publicly funded health care for immediately necessary medical treatment only. I understand that if not entitled to free treatment, I will pay for any health care or medical assistance I or any person included in my application may require in New Zealand.

I authorise NZIS to provide information about my state of health and my immigration status to any health service agency. I authorise any health service agency to provide information about my state of health to the NZIS.

I authorise NZIS to make any enquiries it considers necessary in respect of information provided on this form in order to make a decision on this application and enquiries about my subsequent immigration status. I authorise any agency which holds information (including personal information) relevant to those matters to disclose that information to NZIS.

If granted a Limited Purpose Permit I understand that I am subject to immediate removal from New Zealand without appeal if I fail to leave New Zealand on or before the expiry date of that Permit.
